Workshop/Inservice Credit: At the end of the workshop, the NY Math Circle will provide an official letter that describes your participation.

Graduate Credit: Through the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) Program at Bard College, you may earn two graduate credits for completion of additional work that documents how workshop material has enriched your classroom teaching. An extra processing fee is required for graduate credit.

Graduate Credit Checklist:

- ✓ Lesson Plan based on material from the workshop submitted.

The plan: Prepare using your school's required format, or be more detailed.

- ✓ Lesson Narrative.

The data: What happened? A report on how the students responded to your lesson.

- ✓ Process Reflection Paper submitted.

The study: What are the implications of what you observed? What might you do differently next time?

- ✓ Fee of \$100, which covers feedback on the first draft of the reflection paper, final grading, and first copy of transcript.
